Famine Relief Fund With 1:1 Match

PWRDF is pleased to report that the federal government has today announced they will match funds donated to Canadian NGOs for famine relief in Africa and the Middle East.

The Famine Relief Fund will run until June 30, 2017. This means for every \$1 donated to PWRDF's famine appeal the government will put \$1 into its Famine Relief Fund (for the government to allocate). The 1:1 match will be applied retroactively to all funds donated since March 17. More than \$140,000 has been donated since our appeal was announced, and money is still coming in from individuals and churches across Canada.

The countries identified by the government for matching funding are the most desperate: Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan and Yemen. A group of neighbouring countries at risk of starvation conditions has also been identified: Cameroon, Chad, Niger, Kenya, Ethiopia and Uganda.

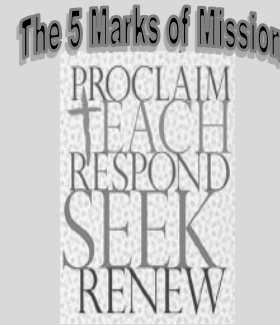
