SUMMER JOB OPPORTUNITY: RESOURCE CENTRE OFFICER – SAINT JOHN: The Anglican Diocese of Fredericton is seeking a summer student to work at its Diocesan Resource Centre to prepare it for another summer of public use. The Centre contains a number of educational materials such as books and video resources that are available for loan to individuals and churches. The student will work normal weekday hours onsite at the new location within the Threshold Ministries Library, located at 105 Mountain View Drive in Saint John. Reporting to Diocesan Staff in Fredericton, the successful candidate will be expected to work well independently. Duties will include organizing the display of materials, updating the catalogue, coordinating the borrowing and returning of resources, and creating an outreach program to cultivate awareness of the Resource Centre.
